## DOES A SUPPLIER HAVE FULL LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEIR DOCUMENTATION, IN CASE OF LACKING OR INCORRECT INFORMATION?

Yes, tier 1 supplier in the supply chain, who issues the Suppliers Declaration of Conformity (SDoC) is responsible for lacking or incorrect information. Ref. MEPC.197(62) 7.1: The purpose of the SDoC is to provide assurance that the related Material Declaration (MD) conforms to section 6.2, and to identify the responsible entity. - DNV GL

According to rules & regulations MSC.1/Circ.1379, SOLAS Reg.II-/3-5 and IACS SC 249 the yards and ship-owners are responsible for collecting Asbestos Free Declarations (AFD) on all components delivered to each project (newbuilding, repair and rebuilding)
